ET PARTICIPATION FEE

The individual participation fees is Rs.100/- (irrespective of groups/category they belong)

The school can hold the 'Entrance Test' (ET) at any time between June and September 2024. To view the schedule, please visit www.spellwellindia.com/schedule. It's best to select the earliest available date to allow students more time to prepare for the District Level Competition (DLC) and subsequently, the National Level Championship (NLC).

PREPARATORY BOOK

Book contains more than 1000 words and exercises useful for the competition. These words and exercises are graded to match the participants' age and class (standard).

Fees Rs.50/- (soft copy)



The fee structure outlined above applies specifically to students registered through their school or from SWI-affiliated schools. Self-registered students must pay the standard fee of ₹250/-.



REWARDS "ENTRANCE TEST" (ET)

- The ET is the gateway to the District Level Competition (DLC).
- Top performing students will receive a selection letter confirming their eligibility to participate in the District Level Competition (DLC).
- Participants will also receive a digital participation certificate.
- The marks obtained in this competition will be considered for ranking.
- The student with the highest marks in each category will be provided with 50% sponsorship for the DLC.
- The names of the students with the highest marks will be published in the selection letter, allowing all selected students to know who has scored the highest from their school.



Rules & regulations

- School registration with the company is free of charge.
- Entrance Test (ET) will be conducted within the school premises, specifically in the computer lab.
- Students can view their marks only after both computerized and manual verification is completed.
- Once the competition results are announced, students can access and download their participation certificates.
- Students can participate in four stages of the competition:
 - Trial Test
 - Entrance Test (ET)
 - District Level Contest (DLC)
 - National Level Contest (NLC)
- The Trial Test is free for all students
- Schools have the option to independently plan and conduct trial tests, or alternatively, they may request students to participate in the trial tests remotely from their homes.
- Students have the convenience of accessing the trial test 24/7. To participate, they
 simply need to log in to their accounts using their unique login ID and password. They can
 do so by visiting the following website: https://competition.spellwellindia.com/
- Participation fees are required for students to take part in the Entrance Test.
- The participation fee for the Entrance Test should be collected by the school coordinator and submitted to SWI via online payment or bank transfer.
- Alternatively, students can make the payment directly to SWI using the online payment facility.
- Participation in any of the contests organized by SWI is not compulsory for any student.
- Schools can place book orders in the prescribed format or online through their respective school dashboard.
- Important updates regarding the competition may be sent to participants through SMS or phone calls by the company or its authorized associates.
- The management reserves the right to change, modify, or update any rules and regulations related to the contest and associated events without prior notice.

Selection Criteria:

- Eligibility for DLC: Students who score above 60% or rank within the top 50% of ET participants (whichever is more) will qualify for the District Level Competition (DLC).
- Physical selection letters will be sent to the top 50% of participants, regardless of whether they registered through the school or self-registered.

Sponsorship Criteria:

- To be eligible for sponsorship by SWI, students must achieve a minimum of 80% marks in all 3-4 types of assessments.
- Sponsorship will be awarded to the top performer in each category based on the standard sponsorship criteria determined by the SWI jury.
- If students participate in both the English Spelling and Sanskrit Shabdamanthan competitions, they increase their chances of achieving higher rankings and securing sponsorship opportunities.
